


You can now see a

What Can They Do?

The Specialist Physiotherapist will be able to:

- Assess you
- Give advice and exercises
- Investigate your condition *and*
- Refer you onto other services *(if necessary)*

Why See Them Instead of Your GP?

The Specialist Physiotherapists are working closely with your GP and hospital services to give you quick access to high quality assessment and advice as early as possible in your journey and to make sure if you do need to be referred on, you see the right person first time.

Who Can They See?

People suffering with musculoskeletal conditions (affecting your spine, neck, bones, joints, or muscles/soft tissues).

- Anyone 16 years of age or under
 - Those only requiring repeat prescriptions
 - Patients with respiratory or neurological conditions
